Due to the increased reporting of persons not following the rules of the range ALL PERSONS WILL BE REQUIRED TO COMPLETE RANGE ORIENTATION PRIOR TO RECEIVING A KEY STARTING WITH THE JULY 2022 RENEWALS. Range orientation classes will start approximately two weeks prior to July 1, 2022. Classes will be held at the range classroom. There will be morning, afternoon and evening classes scheduled and prior registration will be required as there is limited space in the classroom.

Specifically, the infractions included:

Basic Firearm Safety - Never let the muzzle point at anything you are not willing to destroy. All reports received included inadvertently pointing the weapon at another person.

General Membership Rules:

1. It is the responsibility of each member, participant and guest to follow all Big Tiber Rifle and Pistol Club (BTRPC) General Membership Rules as well as Standard and Specific Range Rules.

3. Members are responsible for the actions of their guests. Members will ensure their guests know and understand all BTRPC General Membership Rules as well as Range Rules and Emergency Procedures prior to the guests using the ranges or facilities of the club, and their guests abide by all such rules while on club property.

Rifle Range Rules and Pistol Range Rules:

- 8. Cease Fire Command, Cold Range and Hot Range Designations:
 - b. When a 'Cease Fire' is called, the range is immediately designated a 'Cold Range' and all firearm actions must be opened, emptied of all ammunition, and moved safely to the rack.
 - c. No person may go forward of a firing line except during a designated 'Cold Range.'
 - d. During a 'Cold Range,' all firearms are to remain safely racked and there is to be absolutely no touching or handling of any firearms.

- e. During a 'Cold Range' there is to be no handling of firearms for the purposes of unpacking upon arrival or packing to leave.
- f. All firearms must remain unloaded, racked or packed and untouched, while any person is down range and until the 'Hot Range' designation is called.
- g. Only after the 'Hot Range' designation is called, may firearms be once again moved to the firing line for loading/firing and/or packed and unpacked for transportation.
- 9. A firearm shall not be handled with the muzzle pointed in the direction of any person.

All the rules are posted at the ranges so there is absolutely no excuse.

Also stated in the rules is your membership can be revoked for not following the rules. And please remember these rules are for your safety and for the safety of others around you.
