## COMPLETED RANGE PROJECTS

Since June the following improvements have been completed:

1. the archery range has received new target faces; the backstop has been rebuilt; and new vehicle parking barricades have been installed.
2. The classroom/conex containers: the roof on the classroom has been cleaned and a new weatherization coating has been applied; the classroom has been painted; the ramp and stairs have a new non-slip surface; the conex containers have been leveled and reorganized; maintenance has been completed on the well pump and a hand washing station installed.
3. the pistol range side berm has been removed in preparation for the 50 yard range; a dueling tree has been installed; the concrete pad has been poured for the side wall.
4. the rifle range's parking lot expansion has progressed with tree removal and ground prep; the area around the conduit from the classroom to the rifle range has been brushed in preparation of installing the electrical lines; repairs and maintenance on the berms have begun; the metal targets have been repaired; a 500 yard target has been installed below the 500 meter target.
5. the creek blockage has been fixed between the classroom and rifle range.
