COMPLETED RANGE PROJECTS

Since the last range day (September 3rd) the following improvements have been completed:

- 1. Gutters and drainage has been installed on the classroom building.
- 2. Road to the 500 meter target has been contoured for drainage.
- 3. Brush piles have been moved from the 500 yard area of the rifle range to the archery range. These piles will be burned when burn permits resume.
- 4. Some of the berms have been repaired, however, more needs to be done.
- 5. Brush has been sprayed around the perimited of the ranges (thank you Alan).
- 6. Parole and Probation crew cut vegetation along the road from the age to the rifle range.
