# AUGUST CONCRETE PROJECT

This prep work will be moving EVERYTHING out of the building, i.e. chairs, wood stove, storage items, etc. The stands will be moved 25' forward of the building so people can still shoot while work is being performed. ## A YEAR IN REVIEW

Some of the projects:



We now have a working well by the classroom. The pump was repaired and is now operational for hand washing or filling the portable water tank, however, is not potable water.

The blockage from the creek by the rifle range parking lot has been cleared, and the culvert between the classroom and pistol/rifle range was extended and the water is flowing much better.





The conduit located between the classroom and the rifle range has been unearthed and the path has been cleared so we can revisit extending power to the rifle range.

The classroom roof has been repaired and coated, gutters have been installed, the building painted, doorknobs replaced and anti slip surface has been installed on the ramp





The wall has been installed between the pistol range and 50 yard range. The pistol range will not have to

be closed when work is being performed on the 50 yard range. In May the poles were installed at the back of the 50 yard so the berm can be worked on. Hopefully we will have this range in use, however, it may be a while before the building is constructed.





The parking lot at the rifle range has doubled in size with the expansion.

A solar powered beacon was installed at the middle post to alert people are down range.





A target was installed at 500 yards, below the 500 meter target, as well as a wind sock at the 500 meter.



300 meter target improvements were installed, the berm has been repaired and a wind sock has been installed.





200 meter target, railing and berm improvements were completed.

100 meter target improvements were completed. These targets are similar to one of the regularly scheduled shoots.





Drainage by the 300 meter was installed improving water runoff and driving conditions down range.
