This month's message is about safety. We had an incident of a discharge of a rifle when racking. We did hear about it from the people involved and also a witness. When I got up on the roof to inspect the damage I found more holes. Another one above the rack and a large hole above one of the benches. Two rules are being violated, one is to unload and open the action on the firearm before racking, no loaded weapons behind the yellow line. The other is to keep loaded weapons pointed down range at all times.

The other safrety violation is shown in the pictures, handling weapons and leaving firearms on the benches when people are down range. As said in orientation, YOU are your own safety officer and if you see unsafe actions you have to point them out to the violator.

We will be having a board meeting to determine what sort of actions will take place for the safety violations we are aware of. It will be at the range classroom and will be posted on the website when we determine what day/time it will take place.
